1 a) Election of Vice Presidents (Deferred ex AGM)

Springwell HS nominated Mr G Morris Birtley
Leeholme HS nominated Ms V Grimley Spennymoor
Greenside HS nominated Mr G Kent Lemington

Outcome

General Council confirmed the above nominations and Mr G Morris, Ms V Grimley and Mr G Kent were duly elected as Vice Presidents

b) Election of Auditor (Deferred ex AGM)

3 Oddfellows HS were seeking confirmation of their action in suspending Mr W Mullen for non-payment of fees for the seasons 2018 and 2019 totalling £429.00

4 Mr K Tindell of 7 Devonshire Tower Monkwearmouth Sunderland SR5 1DH was seeking permission for his suspension to be lifted. Mr K Tindell was suspended by General Council on 25th March 2017 for failing to return money owed, Club documents Bank Book and Balance Sheet.
